





How's it Going?

- Debrief feedback from ACs indicates:
 - Increase understanding of the needs of online students (including impact of class size)
 - Importance of ability to observe from outset of the course
 - Increased appreciation for value of instructor development
 - Importance of transparency and impact of tool choice on this issue
 - Importance of upfront planning and realistic expectations re: time commitment for observation



How's it Going? – More Results

- Initial feedback from instructors:
 - Rated preparatory materials in range of "mostly" to "very" effective
 - Underscored importance of reviewing materials provided and attending tutorials/training sessions when possible
 - All reported that feedback session with AC were helpful
 - 50% reported implementing feedback from AC in current semester
 - 75% indicated plans to use feedback to change teaching strategies in the future



Going Forward

- ID support during the initial weeks of the semester
- Enhance orientation materials for ACs
- Support peer-to-peer mentoring
